#### **Solaris appoints former co-ordinator of operations and finance at Wilson and Pinnacle as new COO.**

Australian equities fund manager Solaris Investment Management (Solaris) has appointed Glen Holding as chief operating officer (COO).

Holding will oversee the financial side of the business and look after all of Solaris' outsourced provisions, Solaris managing director Dennis Donohue said.
